

# Pastor's Letter





"As Jesus was going up to Jerusalem, he took the twelve disciples aside, and on the way he said to them, 'See, we are going up to Jerusalem. And the Son of Man will be delivered over to the chief priests and scribes, and they will condemn him to death and deliver him over to the Gentiles to be mocked and flogged and crucified,

and he will be raised on the third day. Matthew 20:17-19

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The captain of the ship looked into the dark night and saw faint lights in the distance. Immediately he told his signalman to send a message: "Alter your course 10 degrees south." Promptly a return message was received: "Alter your course 10 degrees north." The captain was angered; his command had been ignored. So he sent a second message: "Alter your course 10 degrees south - I am the captain." So another message was received: "Alter your course 10 degrees north - I am seaman third class Jones." Immediately the captain sent a third message, knowing the fear it would evoke "Alter your course 10 degrees south - I am a battleship." Then the reply came: "Alter your course 10 degrees north - I am a lighthouse."

In the midst of our dark and foggy times, many voices are shouting orders at us, telling us what to do and how to adjust our lives. Out of the cacophony, one voice says something quite contrary to all the rest - something almost absurd. But the voice happens to be the Light of the Word, and we ignore it at our peril.

In the 20th chapter of St. Matthew's gospel we read that the captain of the ship of salvation announces to His crew that there is an immovable object which lies dead ahead and they are on a collision course with it.

Jesus warns his crew of the collision course they are on with the cross - not so they might change course and avoid it, but so that they might be prepared for it when it happens. Eventually, just as the captain forewarns, the collision occurs. Even though the crew was still not ready for it, only one dies - the captain himself.

If you've ever been in a collision in a car, you know what a crisis this is. Even a little fender-bender can leave you shaking and rattled. As the disciples collided with the cross of Jesus, it left them permanently changed men.

It is in this encounter with the cross of Jesus Christ that we are changed. There, we see the terrible toll of our sin and the death that results from it. It is at the cross that we see ourselves for who we really are; sinners, so loved by God that He would send His only Son to the cross to bear the awful punishment which we all deserve. That's enough to change a person, or at least it should be.

### **Current Projects:**

#### 1. Mid-Maine Homeless Shelter

- Amanda to request approval for \$2,900 for MMHS Elevator project at the February 17 Church Council Meeting.
- Men's Clothing Drive a huge success. Discussed doing it again in a year with emphasis on outreach to various connections that members have with friends, work, etc.
- Board members to bring at least one recipe to March meeting to develop catalog of ideas.
- Brian to inform the Board of upcoming 'Volunteer Day' at Shelter to organize clothing, etc.
- Board to work on list of potential groups / individuals to do meals.

#### 2. Garuna Foundation


- We examined the Garuna Foundation web-site and viewed a video regarding "Garuna Kids." A child sponsorship program for schooling for children in Cambodia. \$30/month covers tuition, books, uniform. Board discussed the value of having a trusted program to invest in as well as a 'global' program to balance the 'local' programs we are involved in.
- We agreed to sponsor 3 children for 2014. The goal is to sponsor 30 children in 2015, which is enough for Garuna to build a school. We will invite Rev. Jeff Ehlers to come to present the program to us for the 2015 Mission Sunday.
