OPENING REFLECTION In your own words, how do you define the word *justice*? What does it mean that God is a just God?

JOSHUA 5:13–15 Traditionally, the man with the sword has been often interpreted as the Son of God before His incarnation. What details from this text reinforce that interpretation? What might His presence here mean for God’s people?

JOSHUA 6:1–5 What is special about the way that God begins His instruction to Joshua? What does that show us about the nature of God’s promises?

JOSHUA 6:6–21 In your own words, using language from the text, how is this a picture of God’s end-time judgment against sin?

JOSHUA 6:22–27 How do we see God’s continued mercy and His continued justice against sin in this section?
