REFLECTIONS

OPENING REFLECTION When you hear the words “David and Goliath,” what is the first thing that comes to your mind, and why?

1 SAMUEL 17:2–11 Using examples from the text, list all the different reasons Saul had for why he didn’t engage in battle, and all the reasons why he should have engaged in battle.

1 SAMUEL 17:33–37 Contrast the beliefs and attitudes of Saul and David here. Where do they put their hope?

1 SAMUEL 17:38–44 Contrast David and Goliath here. How did they each approach the battle, and what does that show you about their confidence?

1 SAMUEL 17:45–51 Connect the different ways that David’s victory over Goliath foreshadows Christ, the Son of David, and His victory over sin, death, and the devil.

FINAL REFLECTION Describe how God gave victory to His people in the narrative and how He has given ultimate victory to you in Christ.
