EXODUS 12:11–13 What is so significant about the manner by which God expects His people to celebrate the Passover?

EXODUS 12:14–20 What do you suppose is so meaningful about the second festival of unleavened bread after the Passover? What might it show us about our lives as God's people today?

EXODUS 12:21–32 Draw correlations between ideas and themes in this text to what would happen with Christ on Good Friday. How are they similar?
